STAY WELL AND SAFE IN WINTER 2022

How to protect yourself while skiing, at your accommodation or a museum: Austria's current COVID-19 rules in a nutshell.

Update: 21/2/2022, valid until 4/3/2022



RESTAURANTS & CAFES

- Guest registration
- 3-G rule (vaccinated, recovered or tested)
- FFP2 masks when not seated
- Food/Drinks to be consumed when seated only, no bar service
- Midnight curfew



APRÈS-SKI

- Currently not possible



ACCOMMODATION

- Guest registration
- 3-G rule (vaccinated, recovered or tested)
- FFP2 masks to be worn in all public areas

EXCEPTIONS FOR CHILDREN

Children under the age of 12 do not need 3-G proof.

Please note: Vienna has different regulations! 3-G proof is required from the age of 6 there. Antigen tests are valid for 48 hours for children under the age of 12.

CABLE CARS

- 3-G rule (vaccinated, recovered or tested)
- 3-G proof is required when purchasing a ski pass, the pass cannot exceed the 3-G validity period
- FFP2 masks to be worn at stations and inside cable cars, as well as outdoors when the 2 m social distance cannot be maintained



ARTS & CULTURE

- Guest registration at events (theatre, concerts, cinema etc.)
- Proof of 3-G is required for events, but not for museums
- FFP2 masks to be worn in enclosed spaces, including when seated at a concert and outdoors when the 2 m social distance cannot be maintained
- Midnight curfew



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- FFP2 masks to be worn on buses, trains, underground trains, ski buses etc.
- Also applies to enclosed station areas and outdoors (on the platform) when the 2 m social distance cannot be maintained

HOW AUSTRIA'S 3-G RULE WORKS

Hotels, restaurants, cultural institutions (theatres, cinemas etc.) and leisure facilities currently require 3-G status (proof of vaccination/recovery). Please note:

- PCR tests are valid for 72 hours, antigen tests for 24 hours*
- Booster jabs (third doses) are valid for 270 days. Second doses are valid for 210 days for those under 18 and for 180 days for those above.
- Proof of recovery is valid for 180 days, then a jab is required.

*Different regulation in Vienna: PCR tests valid for 48 hours, antigen tests only accepted for children under the age of 12
