GASTRONOMY

- * Currently closed. Takeaway and delivery possible
- * Ski huts remain closed and are not offering takeaway either



ACCOMMODATION

- * Currently closed. Includes private accommodations



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

- * FFP2 masks to be worn on (ski) buses, trains and cable cars as well as in stations and on platforms



SKI SCHOOLS & SKI HIRE

- * Ski courses only as individual lessons or with own household members
- * Ski hire can reopen. Please contact your resort



CABLE CARS

- * Are open in general
- * There may be reduced services (operating hours, number of lifts)
- * Face masks (FFP2 mask!) to be worn in cable car areas
- * Capacity reduced to 50% for closed cabins
- * Individual safety measures such as increased frequency, ventilation within cabins, disinfection
- * Tickets and ski passes to be purchased online in advance if possible
- * A negative COVID-19 test no older than 48 hours is required for use of the ski slopes in Tirol



CULTURE

- * Cinemas and theatres are currently closed
- * No events such as theatre performances, concerts, etc.
- * Museums and libraries can reopen (FFP2 mask required)

AND ALWAYS REMEMBER ...



Wear a face mask where compulsory or social distance cannot be maintained

Keep a 2 metre distance to those from other households

Avoid crowds

Wash your hands regularly and avoid shaking hands

Cough/sneeze into a tissue or your elbow

Keep track of your contacts – e.g. with the “Stopp Corona” app
